



Constructing a Hospital Unlike Any Other in the North America

It's amazing how far we've come. What was a vast open space in 2011 is now a 14-storey building, thanks to the efforts of our hospital's planning team, our project partners and the hundreds of construction workers, architects and engineers who have worked on the site.

The activity at Keele St. and Highway 401 signifies that a big change is coming to hospital care for our community. The new Humber River Hospital will be North America's first fully digital hospital – ushering in a new era of healthcare, one which will use the finest possible technology to support a philosophy of patient-centered care.

Integrating the physical construction with advanced medical technology, ground-breaking environmental planning and patient-care innovation is no easy feat. Ours will be a hospital that is green, efficient and smart... one of the finest in the world.

It will have an immediate impact on our patients, and is already attracting interest from healthcare planners around the globe. They are looking to learn from the level of innovation we have integrated into our planning, both in terms of the construction, and what it will mean for patient care delivery. The lessons they learn here will inform the planning of their future hospital facilities.

Despite being one of the largest, most complex construction projects ever in Canada, we'll open on October 18, 2015 – on time and on budget.

Progress Report

- 75% of all construction is now completed
- All roadways are now paved
- Landscaping is well underway, including the planting of over 800 trees
- The Cancer Care, Dialysis, Cardiology, Medical Imaging and Surgical Clinics are almost complete and are currently undergoing air handling testing and balancing

Patient-Care Report

- 80% of inpatient rooms are single patient rooms, for optimal privacy and comfort
- 24hr visiting hours, so you never have to leave the ones you love
- 100% fresh air throughout the entire building, all the time
- Secure online access to your medical record – right at your bedside

We Need Your Help

We have to purchase 55,000 pieces of equipment to provide the most advanced patient care. It will take an investment of \$225 million from you – our caring and compassionate community – to buy the much-needed equipment that will complete our new building.

The provincial government is investing \$1.75 billion to build and maintain the new hospital, but they do not fund the vast majority of our equipment needs. For that we need the strength of our entire community.




