And just a few short weeks later on October 18th your new Humber River Hospital opened its door, ready to care for our community. We couldn't have done it without YOU – our caring and compassionate donors. 
Equipment Update

The technology we have at Humber is truly extraordinary. Each piece plays a vital role in our larger digital vision – to use the latest technology to enhance patient centred care. Many of our equipment pieces, such as our Revolution CT and Discovery IGS are firsts in the GTA and allow us to be at the forefront of medical technology in Canada.

Discovery IGS

Your new Humber River Hospital is the first hospital in the GTA to have three Discovery IGS imagers, recognized as one of the most powerful imaging systems in the world today. They give our care teams unparalleled interventional radiology imaging that can lead to less invasive surgery.



Equipment like our Revolution CT scanners and Discovery IGS imagers further advance our patient centered approach, and put Humber at the forefront of medical technology in Canada. We understand that your health is impacted by your surroundings, so the new Hospital has been designed to be one of the most energy efficient hospitals in North America, with a green roof and 100% fresh air.

Digital

Personalized, intuitive and interactive digital technologies help improve communication and patient comfort as well as increase access to information.

Perhaps most importantly, the new Hospital has been designed with patient comfort and privacy in mind. 80% of the inpatient rooms are single patient, with space for family members to comfortably spend the night. Our new rooms are equipped with state-of-the-art technology systems, including a bedside terminal and 42-inch patient monitor in every room.

We believe that what is good for people is good for our hospital. That's why we've designed the new Humber River Hospital to help us deliver the very best in patient-centred care.




Hearts Bursting With Love!

The Teskey Family: Honouring a Beloved Mother, Father and Nephew

The Teskeys are no strangers to Humber River Hospital. All five Teskey children were born here. Many still live—and work—in the neighbourhood. Their mom, Gertrude, was a nurse, and both she and her husband Howard had surgery at the hospital.

One of their nephews, Phillip Teskey, was treated and subsequently passed away at one of Humber's legacy sites. The family experienced some of the limitations of our older buildings, like having tough discussions about their family member without a lot of privacy.

And so, when the opportunity came up to honour their dear family members with a gift, Gertrude and Howard Teskey's children jumped at the chance. They're thrilled that the new Humber River Hospital will offer other families a more private, patient-centred experience. From the climate and light-controlled rooms, to the dedicated quiet rooms and family courtesy suites, the new hospital was designed for patient and family comfort.

In recognition of the gift from the Teskey Family, two rooms will be named in honour of Gertrude, Howard & Phillip. One is a quiet/consultation room on the Inpatient Wing that will care for patients with cancer. This will be a dedicated space for families to discuss complex and often difficult issues about the care of loved ones. The second room is a counselling office in Cancer Care.



Cheryl Teskey says: "It makes me smile to think about the privacy and comfort families will experience, instead of a chaotic hallway. The spaces are so calm and peaceful. It can be such an overwhelming time when you're in hospital. It's important for patients to feel calm, and empowered. They'll get that here."

Her brothers, Roy and Mark, add: "We had the best doctors already—now we have the best space! It's obvious that much thought went into making it the best patient experience possible. This hospital is truly unbelievable. This gift—any gift to Humber—is an investment in your healthcare. If you live in this community, you're going to need this hospital."




