- The Data Center, the heart of our digital vision, is complete and has been undergoing testing for several months - workers are in the process of installing, programming and running all of the IT, building, fire and life safety systems
- Colour-coded wayfinding signage is up and will help direct patients and their families around our 1.8 million square foot building
- Two brand new MRI machines have already been delivered and installed

- Interior doors open with the use of sensors, helping patients and their families travel through the hospital with ease and without the spread of germs
- Heated floors and sidewalks will help avoid slips and falls in the winter
- Dynamic glass windows in patient rooms help you control your room environment and privacy



Honouring Pio Tomei December 14, 1948 – September 25, 2014

Pio Tomei was a man who lived with integrity and courage, and who chose to smile, rather than sulk. Beginning treatment in July 1996, he was one of the pioneering patients in Humber's Nocturnal Home Hemodialysis Program. This innovative program, founded by Humber River physician Dr. Andreas Pierratos, is a type of dialysis treatment that provides a better quality of life for patients with chronic kidney disease by allowing patients to receive dialysis treatment in their own homes, under medical supervision.

Franca Tomei, Pio's wife, is grateful for the excellent care her husband received from Dr. Pierratos and an excellent team of physicians, nurses, dieticians, pharmacists, social workers and technicians at Humber.

"Pio and I always felt comfortable asking questions. We could always call for help when needed, day or night, and were always encouraged to participate in the care he was given. Dr. Pierratos and his team were always receptive to our questions, feedback and ideas," says Franca.

Upon his passing, Pio's family thought about how to remember him and the treatment he received. They plan to name a park bench near the Dialysis Unit at the new Humber River Hospital in memory of Pio and in honour of his care team.
