Monica, our Nurse Navigator, is an experienced front-line nurse who guides breast cancer patients through their treatment journey, providing guidance, support and resources to patients like Shaniza.

Shaniza was diagnosed with stage 3 breast cancer. She underwent complex and intense treatment that involved chemotherapy, multiple surgeries at



Humber, and radiation at a partner hospital.

Here's how Shaniza describes the importance of Monica's role: "When you have any discomfort, illness, or issue, you call this lady and if she doesn't answer, she will call you back within an hour. She would give me advice, talk to the doctors and either get a response for me or get me an appointment. She's there to help you. She helps you with your own worries and concerns, and she helps you move through what can be a really confusing and complicated time. Cancer care is almost like a whole new language—there are

all these different departments, processes, sequencing of care, treatment options—and Monica is there to explain it all to you, in simple, human language and to answer all your questions. I can't say enough about how much she—and this program—helped me. I'm so grateful to Monica, and to all the donors out there who give to the Hospital."

And here's what Monica shares: "I hear from patients all the time that they love the program and the help and support we offer. I'm here to help every breast cancer patient with their unique journey. Breast

cancer is the most common cancer among women: 1 in 8 women are diagnosed with breast cancer, and it can be overwhelming and cause a lot of anxiety. And there are many different pathways and regimens. So the Nurse Navigator role is a way for me to use my experience as a frontline nurse, collaborate with colleagues across Humber and in our partner hospitals, connect patients to community resources, and help every woman on her own journey."


